**O**n behalf of the City & County of Honolulu and the Board of Water Supply, mahalo for your patience and understanding during the construction to repair and replace the aging sewer and water main system along Kapiolani Boulevard that is more than 70 years old.

We know that the work related to this project has been an inconvenience to you and others who live, work and drive on Kapiolani Boulevard each day. Please be reassured that we are working with all parties involved to minimize the impact to the public and expedite its completion.

Construction has been temporarily suspended to accommodate an increase in holiday traffic. Work will resume in January 2008. This project is expected to be completed in summer of 2008 and is essential to the health and safety of our community. Upon its completion, residents and business will have new water mains designed for an 80-year service life and a rehabilitated sewer system that will last for 50-75 years.

## Work on Kapiolani Suspended for the Holidays

To accommodate the increase in seasonal holiday traffic, work related to this project has been temporarily suspended. Constructing equipment has been removed from Kapiolani Boulevard, Atkinson Drive and Kamakee Street. Crews are scheduled to return to work in January 2008.

## Project Update for 2008

When work resumes in January 2008, crews will continue to be allowed to work 24 hours a day, seven days a week in multiple locations. Work scheduled to take place includes:

### Installation (completion of installation) of the new water main system:

- Kapiolani Blvd. between Ward Ave. and Atkinson Dr.
- Kapiolani Blvd. between Atkinson Dr. and Kalakaua Ave.

### Installation of new sewer force main:

- Kalakaua Ave. from Kapiolani Blvd. to the Ala Wai Canal Bridge.

### Rehabilitation of sewer manholes and laterals:

- Kapiolani Blvd. between Kamakee St. and Atkinson Dr.

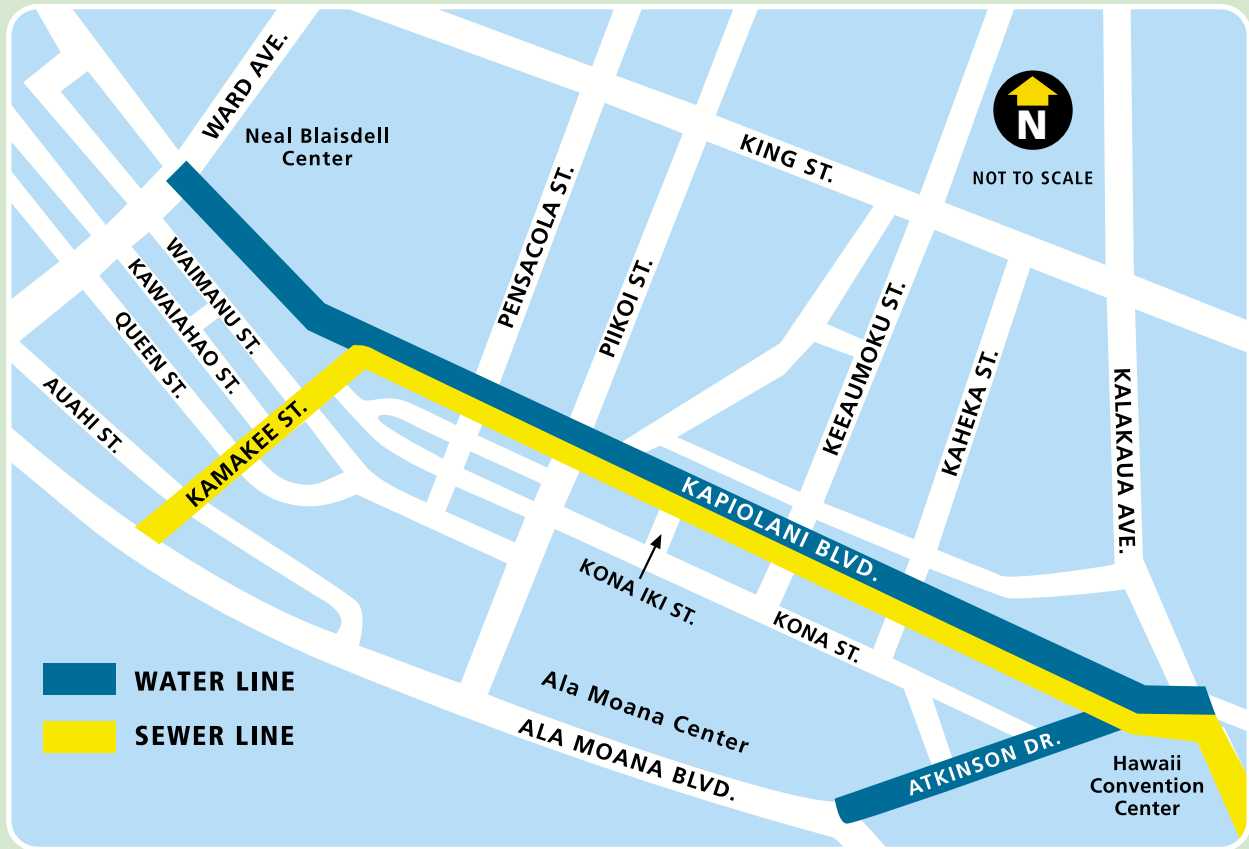
### Installation of curb ramps to comply with ADA requirements:

- Kaheka St.
- Mahukona St.
- Kona Iki St.

### Road Repaving:

- All lanes on Kapiolani Blvd., Kamakee St. and Atkinson Dr. that have been disturbed by construction related to this project will be repaved.

The Kapiolani Boulevard Water and Sewer System Improvements Project is a joint project by the City & County of Honolulu and the Board of Water Supply. The project includes the installation of new water mains, the rehabilitation of the existing sewer system, a new sewer force main on Kalakaua Avenue, and new curb ramps at key intersections for ADA compliance. Construction work will be conducted on Kapiolani Boulevard between Ward and Kalakaua avenues; Kamakee Street; Atkinson Drive; and Kalakaua Avenue between Kapiolani Boulevard and the Ala Wai Canal Bridge. The project is expected to be completed in summer 2008.
